Armourtread® stair treads were developed by Big River Timbers to meet the demand for a superior stair tread material that would remain stable throughout a range of climatic conditions. The result is a laminated stair tread of outstanding strength and stability.

Unlike large section solid timber stairs, Armourtread® stair treads resist shrinkage because each layer of hardwood veneer is dried before manufacture of the laminate.

Genuine hardwood

Armourtread® complements the Big River Timbers range of flooring products, with the same rich, warm hues of Australian eucalypt hardwoods.

Natural or factory-finished

Armourtread® engineered stair treads can be supplied pre-finished (sanded, sealed and coated in the factory) or they can be finished on site to your requirements.

Versatile product

Armourtread® material can also be used for stair trims, balusters, handrails and posts, or as bench tops and tabletops.

Sustainable resources

All Big River Timbers engineered flooring and stair components are milled from managed regrowth and plantation forest hardwoods.

Lifetime warranty

Armourtread® stair treads come with a lifetime structural warranty for domestic applications.

Matching an existing staircase to your floor

Existing MDF staircases can be transformed by covering the treads and risers with plywood sheets or Armourfloor® floorboards manufactured from a range of Australian eucalypt species.

ArmourTrim™ nosing

A special edge trim provides an attractive bullnose finish on the front edge of the treads.

Stair facing

For a smooth continuous finish on the stair tread, without joins, ArmourStep™ plywood sheets can be used to cover existing stair treads. The sheets are supplied in panels 1200mm by 280mm with a tongue on the leading edge that fits into the ArmourTrim™ tread nosing. Available plain or with factory coating.

For covering existing stair risers, ArmourRiser™ sheets can be supplied in 1200mm by 180mm square-finished panels, with a factory coating if required.



Armourtread™ Specifications

Armourtread® is manufactured using a total hardwood balanced construction, forming plywood boards manufactured to AS/NZ2271:1999 "Plywood and blockboard for exterior use" and stress graded in accordance with AS/NZ2269:1994 Plywood – Structural.

Armourtread® is laminated with all veneers in the longitudinal direction and glued using a type B bond.

Each panel is constructed using the same species of veneer throughout its construction. All veneers used in the product are milled from managed regrowth and plantation forest hardwoods.

Armourtread® material can be supplied either in panels, cut to size with square edges or cut to size with a bullnose profile on one long edge.

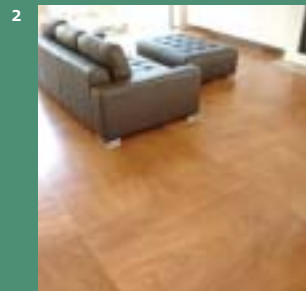

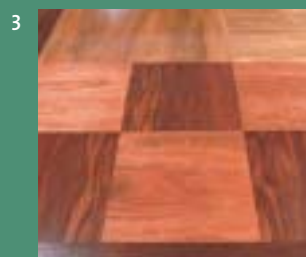

Big River Timbers also manufactures a laminated stair tread of outstanding strength and stability. Unlike large section solid timber stair treads, it is highly resistant to shrinkage. It can also be used for bench tops, stair trims, tabletops, balusters, handrails and posts.
