



# Recycled timber products

The ultimate in beauty and peace of mind.

Big River now offers a complete range of recycled timbers salvaged from demolished buildings and structures around Australia and milled to a high standard of surface finish and dimensional accuracy.

A wide range of recycled timber products is available for structural, architectural and interior applications, including Floorboards, Decking, External Cladding, Stair Treads and Bench Tops, as well as Structural Products such as Posts, Beams and Joists.

## Recycled Timber Floor Boards

Big River offers standard recycled floorboards in two basic colour ranges (Mixed Red and Mixed Cream). These overlay boards are 125mm wide and 12mm thick, with reversible tongue and groove. Other floor boards can be custom milled to requirements.

## Overlay Floorboards

Standard recycled timber floorboards are available in two colour choices (Mixed Red and Mixed Cream). The boards are 125mm wide and 12mm thick, with reversible tongue and groove. Timber is aged on one side and clean on the reverse.

Floorboards can also be supplied up to 260mm wide, with reversible tongue and groove profile, in three thicknesses (12mm, 18-22mm, 26mm) and a wide range of species.

## Decking

Most recycled timbers can be supplied in decking profiles, such as 60mm x 19mm, up to 220mm x 40mm in a range of species.

## Cladding

Lining Boards: Internal lining boards are 12mm thick or to specification, in a variety of profiles, with tongue and groove V-joint or square-edge tongue and groove.

Weatherboard: Manufactured to requirements, as vertical cladding with tongue and groove joint or horizontal cladding with shiplap profile.

## Structural Supports

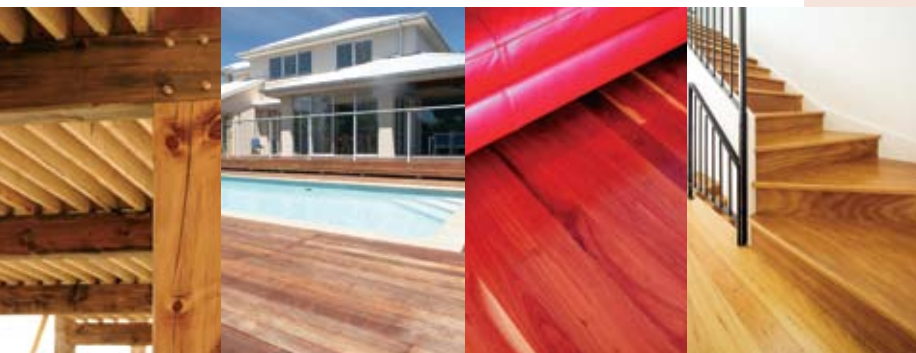
Large posts, beams, rafters and joists are usually available. All timber is straightened, sawn and dressed square and dimensionally accurate. Finish options include sawn, wire brushed or dressed all sides.

## Stair Treads

Treads, stringers and risers are available in a variety of sizes and species, manufactured to specification.

## Bench Tops

Recycled timber can be used to create uniquely beautiful bench tops, manufactured from wide board laminations, generally 150-200mm wide, with overall thickness 38 to 80mm.



## Beauty, stability and peace of mind

Recycled timber is the ultimate environmentally friendly building product. As well as peace of mind, these products provide a superior quality timber that has been seasoned for long periods, in some cases up to a century, offering greater stability than most kiln-dried timber.

Some of the advantages of recycled timber are:

- High strength ratings
- Wide range of sizes and lengths
- Straight, square, accurate sections
- Variety of colours and finishes
- Environmentally responsible

## Appearance

Finish varies according to the condition of the timber before processing. Most products, when milled, have the same fresh appearance as new wood but with the subtle and beautiful tones of aged timber.

Some products can be supplied with an aged appearance, including fine surface checking and distinctive features such as nail and borer holes.

## Hardwood Species

Availability of particular species depends on current stocks. However, most common hardwoods can be supplied, including Blackbutt, Spotted Gum, Blue Gum, Tallowwood, Brushbox, White Mahogany, Ironbark, Jarrah, Karri, Red Mahogany and Grey Gum.

## Moisture Content

Recycled timber can be supplied with specified moisture content.

## Durability Ratings


Variety of class 1 and 2 materials available for external applications.

## Strength Ratings

Timber can be supplied with strength ratings from F14 through to F34, according to availability.

## Certificate of Compliance

Big River can supply a compliance certificate, where available, indicating the type of building and the location from which the timber was sourced.
